- Undertake the preparation, testing, installation, calibration and configuration of Seiko's systems prior to major events, including unloading equipment, rigging network infrastructure, calibrating systems, and performing pre-event checks.
- Take a role leading a team of technicians at events acting as a central point of focus for any queries and offering support to troubleshoot and resolve any technical issues.
- Ensure accurate capture, processing and output of all competition timing and results in line with governing regulations.
- Liaising with competition officials, volunteers, athletes, Staff and other key stakeholders to ensure the successful delivery of services.
- Efficient and safe de-rigging and load-out of equipment post event.
- Completing any fault or escalation reports post event and following through to ensure resolution.
- Assist in planning and executing hardware and software upgrades on systems between events to optimise performance.
- Work with development teams on specifying operational and user requirements for new and enhanced system features and testing features when delivered.
